Artistic Director's Notes

Winnie the Pooh came into public domain January 1st 2022. So now anyone can use the characters in any kind of story they choose (just not the Disneyfied version). The original stories were meant as an entertainment from a father to his son. Those stories became popular all over the world: Vinni Pukh (Russia). Kuma no Puu-san (Japan). Winnie l'ourson (France). Winnie der Puuh (Germany). Micimackó (Hungary) and many, many more. The latin version, "Winnie ille Pu". is the only version of the stories to make it onto the New York Times best seller list. Winnie the Pooh cafés are extremely popular in South Korea. Italy. Nigeria. and even China – where many images of Winnie have been censored since Chairman Xi Jinping was caricatured as Winnie walking beside President Obama's Tigger.

Winnie the Pooh is often considered the most beloved children's book in the world. There is a slightly sadder side to the real-life Christopher Robin. He felt betrayed by his father for publishing stories which were meant just for a lonely son. That led to a far greater breakdown in their relationship, as Christopher was taunted and haunted by the image of his five year-old self. This led to Christopher not speaking to his parents for the last fifteen years of their lives.



This show includes a few of my favourite stories about Winnie and his friends. It encompasses the joy and laughter of those original stories. But it is set within the broader world of the real Christopher Robin's struggles with the loss of his childhood.

I'm sure Winnie's adventures will make you giggle. But it might make you sigh and wipe away some tears as well.

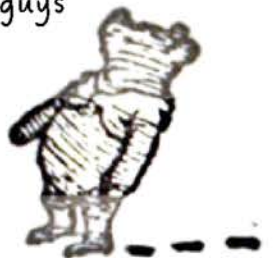
Alerah Ross
